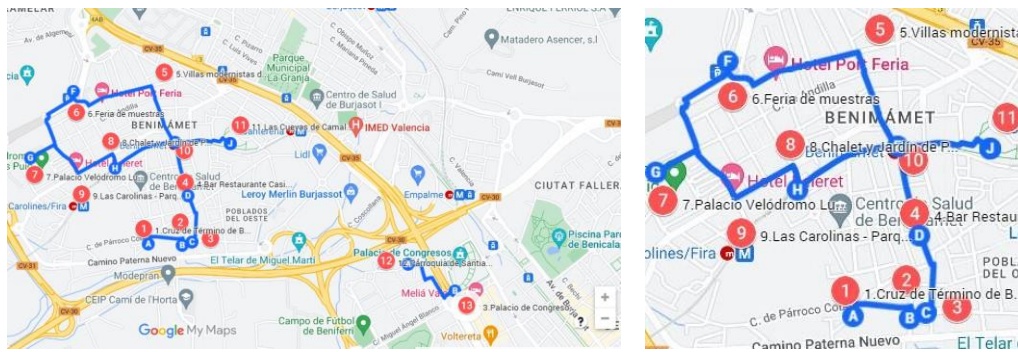


#### 4. Benimàmet Agricultural and Musical Worker's Instructional Society.



#### Benimàmet Agricultural and Musical Worker's Instructional Society

The **Agricultural Worker's Instructional Society** was founded in 1905; it was an initiative of a group of residents, many of them farmers, as a meeting and leisure place, as well as a place for commercial exchange.

In 1921, the building was constructed with two spaces: a room for a meeting place and bar, **el Casino Cervantes**, where, since 1923, the Society had been founded, and it was a social centre where people played cards, dominoes or did business, and another room used as a cinema: **Cervantes Cinema**.

In 1972, the Benimàmet Musical Educational House, whose main function was to teach music using a Musical Band, merged with the Society and took its current name of **Benimàmet agricultural and musical workers' instruction society**.

The current building is a remodelling of the original. It is mainly used as a bar-restaurant.

It is Benimàmet's Music Venue. Its brass band has maintained the tradition for generations.

The Cervantes Cinema became a multi-purpose hall, a rehearsal and concert hall used mainly by the music band, and for cultural performances.

It is located in a flat area, dropped kerbs and non-slip flooring.

##### Car park

Two spaces are reserved for PRM in Calle Felipe Valls, 8 and 36. It has vertical and horizontal signage, through an accessible route. 200 cm x 500 cm.

Two spaces are reserved for PRM in Calle Felipe Valls, 8 and 36. It has vertical and horizontal signage, through an accessible route. 200 cm x 500 cm.

## Indoor Mobility

The space between tables is more than 80 cm.

There are corridors with a clear passage width of more than 100 cm.

The cafeteria connects to an outdoor patio with an accessible itinerary containing a terrace with tables with more than 80 cm of separation. The toilets are located in this outdoor courtyard.

## Toilets

Adapted exclusive toilet within an accessible route.

Access using a 10 cm long ramp with a 30% slope before the door.

There is a door with a free passage width of 85 cm. There is a washbasin with a lower height of 78 cm, an upper height of 84 cm and a depth of 36 cm. It has a mixer tap. Non-tilt mirror with a lower height of 110 cm.

Toilet seat located at a height of 40 cm. There are folding bars on both sides, 62-76 cm high. The spacing between bars is 68 cm.

## Access

Access is by ramp with 4.5% slope more than 200 cm wide and more than 200 cm long. No tactile-visual signage at the start and end of the ramp. No handrails. Non-slip flooring.

## Indoor Mobility

The cafeteria connects to an outdoor patio with an accessible itinerary containing a terrace with tables with more than 80 cm of separation. It has 4 columns and an unmarked beam.

## Toilets

Gents' and ladies' toilets marked with contrasting pictograms, located at a height of 160 cm.

Access to the toilet area is through a 7 cm rim.

Homogeneous lighting with a timer.

## Access

Access is through semi-glazed doors.

## Toilets

The toilets have no vacant/engaged visual system.  
There is no lower clearance band in the cabin.

## Car park

Two spaces are reserved for PRM in Calle Felipe Valls, 8 and 36. It has vertical and horizontal signage. 200 cm x 500 cm.

It is located in a flat area, with an accessible route.

## Access

Access is by ramp with 4.5% slope more than 200 cm wide and more than 200 cm long.

## Indoor mobility

There are aisles with a clear passage width of more than 120 cm without narrowing.

The access door to the Sebastián Benlloch Hall has a clear passage width of more than 200 cm and is permanently open.

## Toilets

Adapted exclusive toilet within an accessible route.

Access using a 10 cm long ramp with a 30% slope before the door.

There is a door with a free passage width of 85 cm. There is a washbasin with a lower height of 78 cm, an upper height of 84 cm and a depth of 36 cm. It has a mixer tap.

Non-tilt mirror with a lower height of 110 cm.

Toilet seat located at a height of 40 cm. There are folding bars on both sides, 62-76 cm high. The spacing between bars is 68 cm

## Access

Access is by means of a ramp preceded by a 2 cm ramp rim, with a 4.5% slope, which is more than 200 cm wide and more than 200 cm long. There are handrails on each side at a height of 90 cm. Start and end of ramp not marked. There is non-slip and homogeneous flooring.

Access is through semi-glazed doors that are permanently open when events are taking place.

### **Indoor Mobility**

There are no unmarked overhanging elements. Homogeneous lighting.

From the Sebastián Bosch Hall there is direct access to the outdoor patio of the bar where the terrace and the toilets are, and an accessible route using a ramp with a 10.6% slope with a length of 109 m and a free width of 137 cm.

### **Toilets**

Gents' and ladies' toilets marked with contrasting pictograms, located at a height of 160cm.

Access to the toilet area is through a 7 cm rim.

Homogeneous lighting with a timer.

### **Access**

Access is through semi-glazed doors.

### **Indoor Mobility**

There are pictograms and texts in large, contrasted fonts indicating spaces and routes.

### **Toilets**

The toilets have no vacant/engaged visual system.

There is no lower clearance band in the cabin.
